

AECEA Event Terms & Conditions

By registering for and attending an AECEA event, you agree to the following terms & expectations:

Respect for Participants

AECEA is committed to creating welcoming, inclusive, and respectful spaces where early childhood educators can connect, learn, and build community. All participants are expected to contribute to an environment that is respectful of differing perspectives, experiences, and identities.

Harassment, discrimination, intimidation, disruptive behaviour, or conduct that makes others feel unsafe or unwelcome will not be tolerated.

Photography, Video, and Privacy

To help create a comfortable environment for all participants, please respect the privacy of others.

Participants may not take photographs, videos, or audio recordings of other attendees without their prior consent. If consent is provided, participants are expected to use good judgment and respect any request to delete or refrain from sharing images or recordings.

Respect for Event Resources and Materials

Resources, worksheets, presentations, and other materials shared during events are intended to support professional learning and engagement.

Unless otherwise stated, these materials may not be reproduced, redistributed, modified, published, or represented as your own work without prior written permission. Where sharing is permitted, appropriate acknowledgement of the source is expected.

Commercial Activity and Self-Promotion

AECEA events are intended to foster connection, collaboration, and professional dialogue.

Participants may not use these events to solicit clients, recruit customers, promote commercial products or services, distribute marketing materials, or otherwise engage in unauthorized self-promotion. Limited sharing of professional experiences or organizational affiliations within the context of conversation is welcome, provided it is not promotional in nature.

Assumption of Risk

Participation in AECEA events is voluntary.

Participants attend and participate at their own risk. To the fullest extent permitted by law, AECEA is not responsible for any personal injury, illness, loss, theft, damage to personal property, or other claims arising from participation in or travel to and from an event.

Participants are responsible for determining whether an activity is appropriate for them and for taking reasonable precautions for their own health and safety.

Compliance with Event Expectations

Participants are expected to follow any additional instructions or safety requirements communicated by AECEA staff, volunteers, event hosts, or venue representatives.

Failure to comply with these Terms & Conditions may result in a participant being asked to leave an event without refund (where applicable) and/or being restricted from attending future AECEA events or initiatives.
