Exploring Early Childhood Curriculum

Accepting Expressions of Interest from July 7-19

This free online course is for educators wanting to learn how to use *Flight: Alberta's Early Learning and Care Framework* to guide their daily practices.

Who is the course for?

This non-credit online course has been designed for educators who are working with young children and their families in accredited and approved programs. The course is offered in English or French.

This term the option of an out of school care version of the course, specifically geared for educators working with school age children and their families, will be offered.

What does the course involve?

The course is 22-weeks and includes virtual classes, online discussions and reflective writing assignments. Course participants commit about 4-6 hours per week to course learning activities, and upon successful course completion will receive a certificate.

Why would educators take the course?

The course helps educators increase their reflective practice, understand the importance of responsive early childhood practice, and make the important work they do visible and valuable.
